The Madison (WI) Metropolitan School District grants students the ability to use different names or pronouns at school without it being involuntarily disclosed to their parents. A lawsuit has been brought challenging that policy.

An alarming new Gallup poll shows 71 percent of Americans now support "same-sex marriage." This is a 44 percent jump from the first such poll taken in 1996. As the AFA of PA and others warned: Once same gender "marriage" is normalized too many Americans will forget what real marriage is.

President Biden's **"pride" month proclamation** for

2022 was expanded to include "intersex". - "A Proclamation on Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, And Intersex Pride Month".

Mattel has revealed a new Barbie doll modeled after transgender Laverne Cox.

In response to a judge blocking a law requiring people who identify as transgender to show proof of a "gender transition" to alter the sex on their birth certificates, the Montana Health Dept. issued an order declaring it will only record biological sex, not gender on birth certificates.

In response to a letter from Senator Marco Rubio, the Air Force cancelled a "Drag Queen Story Time" for the young children of service members at Ramstein Air Force Base in Germany.
