News from National Scene

Pride Month pushback: Alabama, Arkansas, Indiana, Tennessee, Utah passed resolutions proclaiming a version of “Nuclear Family Month”.

In Wenatchee, Washington, a school’s **Turning Point USA** chapter got Family Month banners posted on light poles that in the past had displayed rainbow flags. A local LGBTQA+ group Out NCW, struck back by buying two billboards and passing out yard signs supporting Pride.

The **US Department of Education** is celebrating June as Title IX Month, in honor of the legislation that was signed into law in June 1972. Title IX ensured women and girls had equal opportunities in education and sports.

A recently released **Gallup poll** shows support for LGBTQ issues may have reached its peak and is now declining. It also reveals that fewer Americans support same-sex marriage or viewing gay relationships as morally

acceptable. Most Americans still support same-sex marriage at 65 percent, that support has fallen six percentage points since 2023.

The majority opinion by a three-judge panel from the **U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia** upholds a ruling by U.S. District Judge Ana Reyes in Washington which found that President Trump’s executive order which banned transgender troops likely “violates their constitutional rights.”

Corporate sponsorship of LGBTQ has declined, but **Abercrombie and Fitch** still fully supports the agenda! Throughout the years has helped raise more than \$6.6 million in support of the LGBTQ youth activists’ group, **The Trevor Project**
