News From Around PA Federal Judge Michael **Baylson** ruled that the Trump administration's attempt to withhold \$1.5 million in federal law-enforcement money from grant Philadelphia (because of its designation as a sanctuary city) "violates statutory and constitutional law."

Brian Congressman Fitzpatrick (PA-8) has joined 22 other Republicans, including Charlie Dent (signed before he retired), and Ryan Costello (PA-6) in signing a discharge petition to force **four immigration** bills out of committee and to a vote before the full US House. The petition was originated by Democrats and requires 218 signatures.

Governor Wolf announced \$900,000 in grants to help 200 schools make **breakfast** available for all students. Schools will use the grants to

increase and sustain breakfast participation by 20 percent by implementing or expanding alternative breakfast options, such as grab-n-go breakfast, breakfast in the classroom, and second chance breakfast during study halls.

Fourteen governors, including PA Governor Tom Wolf, sent a letter to US Dept of Health and Human Services Secretary Alex Azar threatening to sue if the proposed Title X rule that would defund Planned Parenthood by \$60 million goes into effect.
