Democrats in the Virginia Senate Rules Committee **killed a bill** that would have required medical professionals to provide care to babies who survive abortion procedures and would have made failing to do so a felony.

Alexandria, VA Mayor Justin Wilson unveiled a proclamation announcing March 10th as "Abortion Providers Appreciation Day." Pushback from the Democrat stronghold forced him to remove the proclamation from the docket that the city council was to consider on March 8th!

Oklahoma State Senate advances bill modeled after **Texas Heartbeat Act**. "We are very carefully mirroring this off the Texas heartbeat bill," Oklahoma Heartbeat Act Author Sen. Julie Daniels, R-Bartlesville, said.

Democrats in the US House voted down a motion to consider GOP legislation that would immediately approve the Keystone XL pipeline, remove restrictions on natural gas exports, restart the oil and ga leasing program, protect energy and mineral development and replace oil tapped from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve.
