News from Around PA

Representative Nancy Mace (R-SC) introduced a **resolution to expose the sexual harassment records of Congress.** A motion was made to send it to the House Ethics Committee, whose leadership has said they will do nothing with it! Only 65 of the House's 435 members voted to have the info exposed - three from PA: Brian Fitzpatrick (R-Bucks), Ryan Mackenzie (R-Lancaster) and Scott Perry (R-Dauphin).

Welcoming Schools, a **Human Rights Campaign** program that "provides LGBTQ+ affirming resources and training to K-12 schools", hosted its National Day of Reading recently — marking its 11th year of "bringing queer-focused stories and discussions to kids across the US." In Philly 10 libraries associated with the Free Library of Philadelphia system were part of the efforts.

LGBTQ activists have opened a new **Philly Pride Visitor Center** in time for the 250th!

News from National Scene

University of Arizona partnered with the Center for Biological Diversity to distribute free "reproductive health emergency kits": condoms, birth control, emergency contraception, lubricant, and menstrual products. Stating: "climate change disproportionately harms women and gender diverse people". The reproductive emergency kits will "fill this gap."

The nine-year battle of an **Indiana music teacher** who refused to refer to students by their "preferred" pronouns and/or names has finally come to an end. The Brownsburg Community School Corporation agreed to pay him \$650,000 after it forced him to resign.

Chicago Public Schools refused to allow Moody Bible Institute to participate in its student teaching program, citing its policy of hiring only employees who aligned with its faith values. However, after Moody's religious discrimination lawsuit, Chicago Public Schools has changed their policy!

Signing the "**fetal heartbeat**" bill into law makes Wyoming

the fifth state to protect unborn babies at six weeks gestational age.

Assistant Secretary of Health Admiral Brian Christine, MD and Alex J. Adams, PharmD, MPH, Assistant Secretary for Administration for Children and Families sent a letter to all 50 states saying in part, "Children cannot be removed from a home because the parents do not agree with the child's claim they are the opposite sex. This is not child abuse. States must adopt clear definitions of child abuse and child neglect. "

Torrey Pines High School in California had a large student walkout opposing ICE. Signs such as "ICE is KKK" were allowed on school property. However, a conservative student with a sign saying "We  ICE ~ Real Americans" was suspended!
