News From Around PA

Therapy Center of Philadelphia, in partnership with Philly Family Pride, will launch a new support group targeted at LGB women and transgender individuals considering becoming parents.

On March 20th former Weatherman, **Bill Ayers** was on Penn State's main campus as part of a panel discussion on education equity issues titled "The School to Prison Pipeline."

Recently **Governor Tom Wolf** gave his budget address. He used that speech to push for the passage of HB and SB 300 which would give special protections to homosexuals.

Budget Secretary Randy Albright made the Wolf administration's position unequivocal: Gov. Tom Wolf's budget is a comprehensive plan and its parts shouldn't be evaluated individually. Albright also said the administration isn't interested in considering anything other than a comprehensive plan that does what Wolf's proposed budget intends to do – any counterproposal that fails to meet that requirement won't be entertained by the administration.

News from National Scene

Weekly detention and departure reports from **U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement** shows there were 167,527 non-detained convicted criminal aliens in the US as of January 26th.

Arizona Supreme Court has ruled that if a judge does opposite-gender weddings, they must also do same-gender weddings as well.

Public health officials across the West Coast are urging medical professionals to look out for cases of **ocular syphilis** – a sexually transmitted disease that can

cause blindness. The majority of cases are men who have sex with men.

Two homosexual groups, **OutVets and Boston Pride** were permitted to participate in the St. Patrick's Day parade after organizers lifted a longtime ban on such organizations.

Medicare, Medicaid, Obamacare and Social Security

devoured more than half of the 2014 US budget at 51 percent of spending.
