In a recent Facebook post entitled **“Gettysburg at a Crossroads: Will We Preserve Our Heritage as America Turns 250?”** Senator Doug Mastriano expressed concern for Gettysburg, “In recent years, however, the public identity of downtown Gettysburg has taken a sharp left turn away from that historic focus. Pride festivals that close Lincoln Square, rainbow flags across storefronts and the growing prominence of activist messaging have become a defining visual feature of the town’s commercial district.”

Who knew there was such - **“National LGBTQ Health Awareness Week”**. Rue Landau, Philadelphia’s first openly LGBTQ+ councilmember, will host the first ever LGBTQ+ Health Fair created by city council on March 21 at The Church of Saint Luke & The Epiphany.

Presque Isle Rise Up (Erie County) “supports the well-being and concerns of the LGBTQIA+ community and

welcomes Q+ people and allies to join in its work.”

The **LGBTQ Center in Harrisburg** is hosting a GSA Summit at Dickinson College in Carlisle. On April 21st the session will target high school students and State Rep Ismail Smith-Wade-El (D-49) will be the keynote speaker. The April 22nd session will also target high school students and the keynote speaker is Ashleigh Strange, the executive director of Governor Josh Shapiro’s Advisory Commission on LGBTQ Affairs. “They” will also present on April 23rd targeting college students. “They” live in Allentown with “their” partner!

A **Peters Township High School (Washington County)** senior posed as an attractive adult film star from the Netherlands on social media platforms that included Snapchat and TikTok. He tricked his underage victims (ages 14 to 17) into sharing sexually explicit videos and photos with him. In two cases, he demanded \$500 from the victims after threatening to release the embarrassing material. He’s been charged with 304 felony counts.

News from National Scene

Oregon Democrats voted for **infanticide** by blocking House Bill 4087, the Born Alive Infants Protection Act. All Dems voted against it and all GOP voted for it!

Eric Batman, who has worked for **Los Angeles County** for 24 years, is suing the county and its Department of Public Works for refusing his request to work remotely full-time for the month of June while his workplace displayed the “LGBTQ Pride” flag.

The number of **babies killed in abortions in Massachusetts more than doubled in 2024**, with newly released state data showing 49,450 abortions compared to 24,355 in 2023 That’s a 103% increase and it’s largely attributed to telehealth and the abortion pill.
