Celena Morrison, executive director of the city's Office of LGBT Affairs, announced, without explanation, the cancellation of the annual Trans Day of Visibility flag-raising event. However, the "trans" pride flag will still fly at City Hall from Thursday, March 28 through Sunday, March 31.

Other PA cities will be holding their own transgender flag raising on March 31<sup>st</sup> - **Trans Day of Visibility.** They are Reading, Allentown, Bethlehem, Wilkes Barre.

Assistant Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services, "Admiral Rachel Levine", (biological male who identifies as female), will hold an hourlong fireside chat in collaboration with the of Department Veterans Affairs, Center for Minority Veterans and PrideVA.

"John Doe" a former inmate at the George W. Hill Correctional Facility in Delaware County sued the county claiming he was denied a kitchen job at the jail while incarcerated and his HIV-privacy rights were violated. The lawsuit was settled for an undisclosed monetary payment and policy changes within the facility.

State Rep. Dawn Keefer, GOP chair of the Pennsylvania Freedom Caucus, is the lead plaintiff in the lawsuit challenging Biden's executive order directing federal agencies to work with private, nonprofit groups in get-out-the-vote efforts. The lawsuit contends that the executive order violates Act 88, a state law preventing private dollars from funding election administration.

**News From National Scene** A prominent article in a recent edition of The Dive, a newsletter produced by the Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Accessibility Office in the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, was written anonymously. It starts out, "I am an intelligence officer, and I am a man who likes to wear women's clothes sometimes. I think my experiences as someone who cross-dresses have sharpened the skills I

use as an intelligence officer." Our taxpayer dollars at work!

The Inuit **Diversity, Equity, Inclusion (DEI)** report, boasts that they've "made progress in improving representation" by hiring fewer white people. The percentage of white employees dropped every year. Inuit now owns TurboTax, MailChimp, QuickBooks, Mint, and Credit Karma.

Glassbrook Elementary School, in a low income section of Haywood, California pays two-thirds of its staff six figure salaries. Two years ago it paid \$250,00 for a teacher training service called Woke Kindergarten. The program's website says it supports "children, families, educators, and organizations in their commitment to abolitionist early education and pro-black and queer and trans liberation."
