Last year Unionville-Chadds Ford School District (Chester County) brought in a "queer witch", who identifies as "gender queer" and goes by male pronouns, to talk to 14year-olds about safe dating. The district ignored parents' complaints. But the issue has resurfaced as it has been discovered the students were also given a sex-themed survey. The district has refused to respond to a Right to Know Request concerning the presentation.

New Hope (Bucks County) and Lambertville, NJ (just across the Delaware River from New Hope) will be holding a joint Pride Fest May 17-19.

Five state boards have officially adopted policies that oppose the use of conversion therapy i.e. talk therapy for gender confused minors. This will be used to revoke the license of Christian therapists who use Scripture to help clients.

National Scene From Heartbeat International, **CompassCare** and several other pregnancy help organizations are suing to block legal action threatened by New York Attorney General Letitia James, against pro-life ministries that offer and/or promote Abortion Pill Reversal.

Texas has a state law against "gender affirming care" for minors. The city council of Austin just voted 9 to 1 to ignore that law and become a "transgender sanctuary city".

Rochester Institute of Technology transgender runner "Sadie" Schreiner shattered two women's track records at the Liberty League meet. Both times would have placed him last in the men's races.

Over dozen House Democrats (none from PA!) joined Republicans to pass HR 1112 denouncing Biden's border policies.

A New York judge ruled that a proposed abortion amendment, which would prevent the state from enacting any laws that restrict access to "reproductive autonomy" or "reproductive health care" could not appear on the ballot this November.

States currently suing the Biden Administration over changes to Title IX which completely rewrite the law: Missouri, Iowa, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Nebraska, North and South Dakota, Texas, Alabama, Louisiana, Kentucky

Itasca County, Minnesota just completed a new \$75 million jail. In it is a two-story mural of the Ten Commandments in the facility's gym, as well as other motivational statements on faith and governance throughout the jail, including quotes from President Ronald Reagan and the phrase "One Nation Under God". The Freedom From Religion Foundation has sent a demand letter, citing outdated court cases, saying the displays are unconstitutional.
