Check Our Recent Interview Guest: Karen England, Capital Resource Center Topic: PTA and sex ed News From Around PA KDKA Radio talk show host Marty Griffin repeatedly "misgendered" PA Health Secretary "Rachel" Levine during a phone call with 70 reporters. When Levine asked Griffin to stop saving "sir," Griffin apologized profusely. However, as a result of the confrontation and to show support for Levine, Pittsburgh Mayor Bill Peduto cancelled a scheduled interview on KDKA's Lynn Hayes-Freeland show.

Due to fear of COVID-19, Montgomery County Commissioners have announced a delay in the distribution of 59,000 flags. Normally, they are given to 59 different organizations to distribute throughout the county. GOP Commissioner Joe Gale called the decision "disgraceful" and is working with VFW Post 1074 and other local groups to buy flags independently.

State Representative Daryl Metcalfe has introduced a memo calling for the impeachment of Governor Tom Wolf due to his handling of the coronavirus pandemic.

PA Secretary of Education has announced schools will probably open in the fall and they will provide guidance.

Governor Wolf announces churches in counties which move to the "yellow phase" can hold services, but they must take steps to protect their congregations.

Dr. "Rachel" Levine announces contact tracing will be carried out by health department staffers, public health students, new hires.
