Deadline to register to vote in the **May 19th primary** election is May 4th.

Democrats in the State House continue bouncing the Fairness in Women's Sport Act (HB 158) and the Dads Defending Daughters bill (HB 1849) from one committee to another. This week, without allowing debate, the Democrats on the House Judiciary Committee re-referred the bills to the House Health Committee.

"Pride IN FULL COLOR" will take place in New Hope, PA and across the bridge into Lambertville, N.J. May 9-17.

News from National Scene

The 5th Circuit Court of Appeals on Friday rolled back access to the **abortion pill** mifepristone nationwide — blocking a 2023 FDA policy allowing the drug to be prescribed by telemedicine and delivered by mail."

Implementing **President Trump's Executive Order 14168**, a February 2025 message directed to all U.S.

Navy units, noted the policy of the US is to "recognize two sexes, male and female, that are not changeable." Apparently some at Navy Undersea Warfare Center (NUWC) Newport Division (Rhode Island) didn't get the memo!! It took complaints from a female Dept. of Navy employee and Liberty Counsel's demand letter to get NUWC to require two men who claim to be women to stop using female restrooms.

The **Capital City Rescue Mission** continues its fight with the city of Albany, NY. It houses more than 300 homeless people a night, but many have to sleep on mats. The Christian shelter, with its landmark sign "Jesus Saves", is seeking to build a \$6 million four-story addition on land it owns. The city planning commission claims the mission's 420-page draft environmental impact statement is "incomplete and inadequate". In January 2025 the mission sued the city of Albany in federal court under the Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act. The actions of city council indicate its anti-Christian animosity.

JayCee Cooper, a man who thinks he is a women, has reached an undisclosed settlement with **USA Powerlifting**, after the Minnesota Supreme Court ruled that the organization violated that state's Human Rights Act when it barred him from competing in the women's division.

Vermont Principals' Association has agreed to pay \$566,000 in damages and attorneys' fees to partially settle a religious discrimination civil lawsuit brought by the **Mid Vermont Christian School**. It had been barred from participating in all state-sponsored activities after forfeiting basketball game against another school that had a transgender player.
