News from Around PA

On primary election night, conservative grassroots activist **Scott Presler**, best known for his massive voter registration drives, won a seat on PA's Republican State Committee in Beaver County.

Pennsylvania **Attorney General Dave Sunday** is appealing to the state Supreme Court after a seven judge panel of the Commonwealth Court in a 4-3 decision struck down the state's ban on Medicaid coverage for abortions.

The results of the race to replace **retiring Democrat State Rep Mary Jo Daley** (148th legislative district) are too close to call. Mail-in and provisional ballots are being counted. No Republican filed, so the winner of this race will be the next representative.

News from National Scene

At the **University of Minnesota**, a graduate student reported someone for complaining about "having to change grant proposal language from 'mothers' to 'lactating individuals'".

A seventh-grader at **Drake Middle School in Colorado's Jefferson County Public Schools** was prevented from reading a pro-life poem in class. The school said it was "offensive," "politically charged" and might make other students feel "unsafe."

The **Boston Public Library** has scheduled 19 drag queen story hours across its branches throughout the month of June, most of which are designed for children ages 18 months to five years old.

The principal and athletic director at **Cox Mill High School in North Carolina** ignored the complaints of female students reporting a transgender-identifying male who used the girls' locker room "stared at females while they changed." There is now a call for an investigation.

A lawsuit filed by **Right to Life of Michigan** challenging the state's radical abortion amendment, allowing abortions up to birth has been dismissed by a federal court saying the plaintiffs do not have standing.

Female prisoners have filed a lawsuit against the **Maine Department of Corrections** over what they say was repeated harassment and assault by a transgender prisoner at the women's prison in Windham.

A referendum from the parents' group **Protect Girls Sports in Maine** was to go before voters in November, however the Democrat Secretary of State (and gubernatorial candidate) removed 12,000 "invalid" signatures from the petition and says it is now several hundred names short of the required number.
