Good Bill: HB 1513 – age verification to access porn sites. **Bad Bil:** HB 1518 – driver's licenses for undocumented persons.

Last June a new LGBTQ+ “advocacy group” formed in PA. **Fairness Pennsylvania** is “dedicated to fair treatment and civil rights for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer Pennsylvanians.” The group works year round to push for laws like “The Fairness Act”, which would add “sexual orientation and gender identity or expression” to the PA Human Relations Act impacting employment, housing and public accommodations. This would directly impact Christian business owners, churches and allow men/boys in women/girls’ private spaces. At this point, it is largely funded by Fairness West Virginia.

Philly Dyke March is scheduled for May 31st. It is a “grassroots movement that focuses on activism and empowerment”. Tami Sortman, one of the

organizers, said, “The Dyke March is a protest, not a parade.”

Open homosexual PA State Rep **Malcolm Kenyatta** may lose his DNC vice-chairmanship after a complaint was filed by Kalyn Free — a 61-year-old tribal citizen of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma who unsuccessfully ran for vice-chair. The position is currently held by three individuals. The complaint says that the ballot question, which resulted in David Hogg and Kenyatta’s win, was presented in a way that disadvantaged women candidates, violating the DNC’s procedural rules.

Philly Pride Weekend kicked off on Friday. Last year it featured the world’s largest pride flag – 400 feet. This year’s new 600-foot flag will “travel to various neighborhoods to invite LGBTQ+ leaders and community members to take part in multiple celebratory events.” This will include flag raisings at the Philly Museum of Art and at City Hall.

Qommittee, a national network of drag artists, says

it’s just getting started. The group’s latest project, issued ahead of Pride Month, is a 43-page manual called the Drag Defense Handbook. The group’s specific goal is to counter President Trump’s transgender policies.

The **Texas legislature** passed a series of bills protecting the religious liberty of teachers and students and requiring schools to post our national motto, “In God We Trust,” and the Ten Commandments in classrooms.

Nebraska governor signs **"Stand With Women Act"** into law.

Hawaii tried to unconstitutionally shut down **Child Evangelism Fellowship** (CEF) Good News Clubs in their schools. They lost the case and will be paying CEF a \$100,000 settlement.
