A federal judge has ordered the **Saucon Valley School District** (Northampton County) to allow the 'After School Satan Club' to meet at the middle school at the times and places in the previous agreement made back in February.

Philadelphia students marched to City Hall, chanting, holding signs and sharing their experiences, "demanding protection and support for those who are transgender." They spoke against any legislation at the state and federal levels that would restrict access to so-called gender-affirming care, and remove LGBTQ discussions from classrooms.

An employee of the Gender and Sexuality Development Program at the **Children's Hospital of Philadelphia** met with faculty from Pennsbury School District and Council Rock School District, advising them on how to support students, including one

in kindergarten, attempting to "change their gender."

News From National Scene

Late term abortionist **Leroy Carhart** has died at age 81. He once called unborn children a parasite!

According to the **National Conference of State Legislatures**, about half of state legislatures have introduced bills this year that would regulate students' pronoun usage in school. A majority of those 43 bills would prohibit school employees from using students' "preferred pronouns" if they don't align with their biological sex or their legal name, without first getting parental consent.

Oklahoma Governor Kevin Stitt signed a bill that makes it a felony for health care workers to provide children with treatments that can include puberty-blocking drugs and hormones.

The pornography site **PornHub** has blocked Utah residents from accessing the site in protest of a law fortifying age restrictions on their videos. The law, which goes into effect in May,

requires websites that post adult content to seek age verification and establishes penalties for websites that do not comply.

The Navy brought on an **active-duty drag queen** to participate in a pilot program aimed at reaching a wider audience through popular social media platforms as the military faces severe recruiting shortfalls.

Emerson College in Boston will provide menstrual products, including tampons and pads, in all men's bathrooms.

The **Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago** created a video series in which adults discussed transgenderism and sexual topics with children as young as nine, some of whom identified as transgender themselves.
