#### News from Around PA

The Trump administration moved to abandon its legal fight to obtain medical records of youth who received so-called “gender-affirming care” at the **Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia**. The DOJ needs the medical records of children and teens who have been prescribed puberty blockers and hormone treatments as part of an investigation into possible violations of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act

PA is suing **Character AI** for practicing medicine without a license! The state is targeting it after an investigator found a chatbot on the platform posing as a licensed psychiatrist and providing what the state characterizes as medical advice.

**Delaware County** passed an ordinance in December which required the formation of a county Human Relations Commission. That has not happened and the costs estimates are between \$3000 and \$100000! Remember such commissions have been

used to silence those who do not support LGBTQ agenda

#### News from National Scene

The DOJ is investigating whether **36 Illinois schools** have included “sexual orientation and gender ideology” content in K-12 classrooms. It will also investigate whether these schools allow boys who identify as girls access to girls’ bathrooms and locker rooms.

The **US Department of Education** is starting a Title IX investigation into Smith College, an all-women’s college in Northampton, MA. The problem: The school now admits men who think they are women and gives them access to female only spaces.

In March the city unveiled rainbow sidewalks. Now, the **San Antonio City Council** approved a resolution recognizing May 4 through 10 as Trans+ History Week.

Six “transgender” Idahoans filed a federal lawsuit challenging Idaho’s new law barring them from using restrooms that align with their so-called “gender identity”. Though the lawsuit looks strictly at bathroom

access, the law also applies to locker and shower rooms.

Three Maine residents filed a lawsuit challenging a **proposed referendum** that would require athletes to compete on school teams based on the sex listed on their original birth certificate.

Reversing portions of the Obama administration’s **2016 Equal Access Rule**, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is proposing a rule that would allow federally funded shelters and housing programs to decide placement based on, as HUD Secretary Scott Turner said, “biological truth” and ensure shelters can serve women “as women.”

A **9-0 US Supreme Court** decision confirmed NJ pregnancy centers’ right to sue the state.
