News From Around PA
US Congressman Brendan Boyle (PA-2) signed onto a letter asking President Biden to put in place requirements for airline passengers to provide proof of full vaccination against COVID or a negative test to board a domestic flight.

A **proposed constitutional amendment** has passed the House Health Committee: "The right of an individual to refuse any medical procedure, treatment, injection, vaccine or prophylactic may not be questioned or interfered with in any manner. . . ."

UCLA's pro-homosexual **Williams Institute** recently published a study, "The Impact of Stigma and Discrimination Against LGBT People in Pennsylvania". The study decries the lack of "LGBT-inclusive non-discrimination law, hate crimes law, anti-bullying policies and a ban on conversion therapy." The study further claims, "The social, economic, and health

effects of stigma and discrimination against LGBT people negatively impact the state's economy by tens of millions of dollars each year." The study also shows PA is above the national average in social acceptance of LGB people, so not sure how they reach their conclusions!

News From National Scene

At least 26 **state school board associations** have distanced themselves from the National School Board Association after it urged the Biden administration to use the DOJ against parents who oppose the teaching of critical race theory calling them "domestic terrorists."

Boston city employees can get three months of paid leave if they abort their babies. An amendment "amends the current ordinance by applying the paid parental leave benefit to parents that have experienced a loss of pregnancy."

Harvard University students are hosting **Sex Week**. Workshops scheduled for the weeklong event include "Hit Me Baby One More Time," billed as an "Intro to BDSM." The executive president of

Syracuse University's Student Bar Association and the president of the Student Association are demanding the school strip **Rudy Giuliani** of his honorary law degree citing his past policies as mayor of New York City (he strengthened police powers and removed strip clubs) and his more recent "campaign to overturn the results of the 2020 election".

North Dakota has banned the teaching of critical race theory in public schools.

The **US Department of Health and Human Services** has rescinded waivers granted to TX, MI and SC that allowed agencies in those states to disburse federal dollars to religious entities that are protected under the Religious Freedom Restoration Act.
