A required course for first-year students at **West Chester University** teaches students to resent white people and conditions them to feel guilty about being white.

West Chester Area School District is defending its policy to hide the gender identity of students from parents and to teach gender curriculum in its K-12 schools.

Climate activist members of the University of Pennsylvania's **Fossil Free Penn** could be suspended from other student groups for participation in a homecoming game protest, the school has warned.

News From National Scene

An article published in the *Journal of Medical Ethics* shows that an idea is brewing that would conjure an absolute right to access medical-transitioning interventions. Because people have freedom of

religion, the author argues, transgender people have the right to receive surgery and medical interventions to live as “who” they really are.

A growing number of children and teens are turning to “**tucking**” their **male genitals** or “**binding**” their **female breasts** as a way to get relief from gender dysphoria or just experiment with their gender. Tucking and binding have been promoted by some in the medical community as harmless. However, the American College of Pediatricians and others are telling of the dangers involved in both practices.

The supermarket chain **Kroger** will create a religious accommodation policy and implement new training for store management after settling a \$180,000 lawsuit

from two former employees who objected to wearing a rainbow logo on their uniform.

The Cherokee County (NC) school board voted 5-1 to forfeit all district games against Highlands School, which is in the nearby Macon County School District, “due to safety concerns.” The vote came after a female volleyball player was “forcefully struck” and injured when a transgender player spiked her in the head with a ball.

World Triathlon has decided that biological males can compete against females as long as an athlete’s testosterone level is below a certain level for at least 24 months before competing. The International Consortium on Female Sport has objected to the changes.
