**News from Around PA**  
**Pennsylvania had a 75 percent voter turnout!** Pray for the winners.

The Associated Press has called the **US Senate race** for Dave McCormick, although votes are still being counted and Senator Bob Casey, Jr. has not conceded. The AP called the race because the majority of votes to be counted are from areas that are not favorable to Casey.

**Senator John Fetterman** had some “choice words” on X after more than 65,000 people voted for Green Party candidate Leila Hazou in the US Senate race in PA.

Pennsylvania voters **flipped two Democrat-controlled congressional seats.** Current State Rep Ryan MacKenzie unseated Susan Wild in the 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District. Business owner Rob Bresnahan unseated Matt Cartwright in the 8<sup>th</sup> Congressional district.

The **GOP won all statewide races.** David Sunday will be our next Attorney General, incumbents Stacey Garrity

(State Treasurer) and Tom DeFoor (Auditor General) handily won their elections.

The race for the **72nd Legislative District in Cambria County** was just called on Friday. Democrat incumbent Frank Burns narrowly won re-election. His win means the Democrats will hold a 102-101 edge in the House for the next two years. One hopeful thing is Burns does not always vote with the Democrats!

The GOP has been in control of the **State Senate** since 1996 and will remain in control. However, they did lose one seat as the 15th Senate District went to Democrat Patty Kim. The current GOP senator John DiSanto chose not to run for reelection. Senator-elect Patty Kim is currently a liberal member of the State House. This district covers Harrisburg and most of Dauphin County. The State Senate is now made up of 25 GOP and 23 Democrats. The Democrats have been whittling away at the GOP majority for several election cycles and will continue trying in 2026 when all senators in even numbered Senate districts will be up for re-election.

**From National Scene**  
**President-elect Donald Trump** won 41 percent of the Hispanic vote and more black votes than any Republican in 48 years. Nevada was just called for Trump, giving him 301 electoral college votes, only Arizona has not officially been called. It has 11 electoral votes.

There’s been a lot of finger pointing in the **Democratic Party** with the loss of Kamala Harris. Senator Fetterman said those who pushed Joe Biden out of the presidential race should “own the outcome and fallout” following Harris’ loss.

As of Friday, **Republicans have 53 seats in the Senate,** having gained four seats, while Democrats currently hold 43 seats, including those who caucus with the party.
