The 8th Circuit Court of Appeals has ruled in favor of the City of St. Louis' ban on the free distribution of bologna sandwiches to the homeless. The case was brought by two pastors who were cited back in 2018 for distributing food without a permit. The recent ruling also noted the pastors "sometimes also shared religious literature with the recipients of the food."

Superman: Son of Kal-El, a book series DC Comics launched last year about a bisexual Superman, is being cancelled amid poor sales. This Superman also took on mask to stop the spread of COVID, climate change, school shootings, and the rescue of "undocumented migrants".

Back in July the DOJ quietly announced the formation of the Reproductive Rights Task Force with the stated goal of "protect[ing] access to reproductive health care."

Montgomery County Public Schools, outside of DC, reported shocking data from counseling surveys showing that the number of reported gay, transgender, or nonbinary students increased from 35 in the 2019-2020 school year to 108 in 2020-2021 and 239 in 2021-2022.
