News From Around PA Chambersburg (Franklin County) has passed a socalled anti-discrimination ordinance which includes 'sexual orientation and gender identity' language. This impacts employment, housing and public accommodations. This opens women's bathrooms, locker rooms and shower rooms (i.e. in a local gym) for use by men who identify as women!

School **District** of Philadelphia and Big **Brothers** Big **Sisters** Independence recently partnered together to hold the district's first youth Pride celebration at district headquarters. Big Brothers Big Sisters has been partnering with the district to produce a student Gender and Sexuality Alliance (GSA) for the last three years, and they have organized a virtual district-wide GSA since the fall of 2020.

In response to the **National** School Boards Association (NSBA) letter to President Biden asking that he have the DOJ and FBI investigate parents as domestic terrorists, the Governing Board of the PA School Boards Association voted unanimously cancel its longstanding membership in the NSBA.
