U.S. District Judge David S. Cercone allowed the lawsuit of **Ryan W. Lockhart** to proceed to trial. Lockhart, who is “gender non-conforming,” alleges that he suffered “pervasive workplace bias and harassment” from his supervisor at CDM Resource Management LLC in Export.

The mission of **New Voices** is “to transform society for the holistic health and well-being of Black women, girls and gender-expansive people.” New Voices work to put an end to “patriarchal anti-Blackness via community organizing, leadership development and voter engagement.” They recently hosted a “poetic protest” and voter engagement event in West Philly.

News From National Scene

184,000 comments have been submitted to the **US Department of Education** concerning their proposed rule change that would allow biological males who identify as female to play on girls’ sports and share their

bathroom, shower and locker rooms.

The CDC spent \$85 million on a 5-year grant program which compels schools to increase their support for LGBT ideology. Their lengthy document titled “Promoting Adolescent Health through School-Based HIV Prevention,” states that a requirement for such a grant is to have a school form a Gay-Straight Alliance (GSA) club: in order to be eligible for the grant, schools must “establish or enhance [these] student-led clubs that support LGBT youth.”

Defense Secretary Lloyd Austin released a memo to all branches of the military to raise awareness of the **new DOD program to fund abortion travel**. He said the decision to reverse Roe has “readiness, recruiting, and retention implications for the force,” calling for the military to “establish travel and transportation allowances for service members and dependents ... to access non-covered reproductive health care that is unavailable within the local area of a service member’s permanent duty

station.”

Ultra Beauty, the self-proclaimed largest cosmetic retailer in the US, is getting pushback for having gender-fluid Latinx hairstylist David Lopez – who switches from “he/him” preferred pronouns to “they/them” pronouns based on what gender he feels like at the time – host its online program. The episode hosted by Lopez starred transgender activist Dylan Mulvaney (who has been a girl” since March 12) discussing “the good, the bad, and the silly moments that come with finding girlhood.”

The **Wingate UMC** in Charlotte, NC hosted a drag queen story hour: “children under 14 years old having fun with many different types of crafts and hearing stories read by drag queens and kings.”
