It was hoisted by city's Office the of Immigrant Affairs and was an event sponsored by the Pennsylvania United Chinese Coalition. Its mission is to "improve the CCP's reputation within America as part of a cultural exchange."

Rep. Robert Leadbeter (R-109) plans to introduce a resolution to protest the hoisting of the CCP flag over the City of Philadelphia.

The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) has sued

the US Department of Justice re its request for information on CHOP's "gender affirming care" It has successfully sealed from public release the DOL subpoena. Additionally, CHOP hopes to eliminate three requests: "documents identifying each patient and their individual assessments, diagnoses and treatment plans as well as documents related to their informed consent, patient intake and parental authorization."

News from National Scene

The U.S. District Court for the **Western District of Kentucky** sided with photographer Chelsev Nelson in her ongoing legal dispute with the city of Louisville. She had filed a lawsuit challenging the city's non-discrimination policy which included the term "sexual orientation" forcing her to work "same-sex marriage" ceremonies.

Fairfax County, VA: a male sex offender who claimed to identify as female entered a women's locker room will face no charges despite allegations that he exposed himself to little girls and kept child pornography, as well as a schedule of children's swimming schedules on his

phone. Yes, the county DA is a Democrat!

Harvard University appointed Khubchandani, a Kareem Tufts University associate professor who performs as the drag queen LaWhore Vagistan, as a visiting professor in its Women, Gender, and Sexuality department for this academic year.
