In Philly close to **two dozen chefs and bakers** held a fundraiser. 100 percent of ticket sales will go to the National Network of Abortion Funds and the Abortion Liberation Fund of PA.

Drexel University students this semester can enjoy a stone and granite art installation that is a monument to no one. *Monument in Waiting* is comprised of reclaimed stone plinths and granite tiles devoid of a figure. An inscription engraved on one of the plinths reads, "Until real heroes bloom, this dusty plinth will wait."

Philadelphia School Board has voted to change the name of **Philip H. Sheridan Elementary School** to Gloria Casarez Elementary School. She was an open lesbian, LGBTQ activist and Philly's first LGBTQ Affairs director.

News From National Scene

The Ohio Supreme Court has refused to hear **Oberlin**

College's appeal of a \$36 million judgement against them. The case stems from a 2016 incident in which a black Oberlin student stole wine from Gibson's Bakery. Three students later pled guilty to various charges, but the school's racial grievance groups said the bakery racially profiled the students. The Dean of Students, faculty members and students joined protests outside the bakery demanding the school sever ties with the bakery, which supplied food to the school's cafeterias. The school did temporarily sever ties and in 2019 a jury found the school's actions were defamatory.

Candidates opposed to **critical race theory** flipped school board majorities in five Florida counties.

The **Boy Scouts** had an issue with sexual assault even before voting to allow open homosexuals to serve as Scout leaders: A federal bankruptcy court has approved the reorganization plan for the BSA, which

includes more than \$2.4 billion in compensation to 82,000 sexual abuse survivors. That amount includes \$30 million from the United Methodist Church, which just voted to fully embrace the LGBTQ agenda!

Legislative District 3 GOP in Maricopa County, AZ, have passed a resolution to "ask all citizens of the US to declare that on **Friday, Sept. 23, 2022, Friday Oct. 21, 2022** and on **Sunday Nov. 6, 2022** will be days to steadfastly pray and observe the tenants of God so that our country may be worthy of the blessings of the Covenant; liberty, protection and prosperity"
