Oberlin College's head women's lacrosse coach, Kim Russell, has been "reassigned" to a desk job after she spoke out against allowing biological men to compete in women's sports.

Second Baptist Church in Palermo, Maine is not afraid to let the community know they support life, displaying a sign that reads, "Every Life Matters," and "Abortion is Still Murder." Activists did not like the messages and, over the weekend, delivered their own after spray painting the church's signs. Their messages were "Abortion is our Human right" and "Queer love 4 eva".

President Biden Department Homeland Security announced that the Sexual Minority Youth Assistance **League** had received a \$530,000 Targeted Violence and Terrorism Prevention grant.
