Bryn Mawr College, outside of Philly, has re-energized its effort to promote diversity, equity and inclusion on campus, rolling out a 59-point action plan for the 2023-24 school year that encompasses every aspect of campus life, from curriculum to policies to financial aid.

A 21-year old social media influencer with 200,000 followers on Instagram was arrested by police during the riots and looting in Philly. Blackwell, who goes by the name "Meatball," could be seen in the video screaming "Everyone must eat" and "Free iPhones!."

News From National Scene The Biden Administration has proposed a rule change that would require foster care agencies that accept federal funds and the parents in those agencies to affirm gender confusion. It states: "To be considered a safe and appropriate placement, a provider is expected to utilize the child's identified pronouns, chosen name, and allow the child to dress in an age-appropriate manner that the child believes reflects their self-identified gender identity and expression."

Leaked Department of Veterans Affairs training video instructs staff to confirm that men can get pregnant, advises not to congratulate a pregnant woman, and encourages and glorifies abortions.

The U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals ruled 2-1 to enforce laws protecting gender-confused minors in Kentucky and Tennessee from receiving puberty blockers, hormones, and medical mutilating surgery.

A new "Drag University" program, offered through the school's Gender + Sexuality Resource Center, launched at Princeton University will train students in the "artform." First six students to enroll and attend orientation will receive scholarships to cover cost of supplies.

Polk County, FL Sheriff's Office announced that they had arrested 219 people, including a high school coach, three individuals who worked at Disney, and 35 illegal immigrants during a human trafficking sting named "Traffic Stop 2."
