The new University of Pittsburgh chancellor needs to fix the school's free speech problems, according to conservative student leaders, citing a parade of incidents during the spring semester in which conservative and center-right students/events were vilified and attacked.

News From National Scene The Alaska **Board** of Education unanimously voted in favor of banning males from competing on girls' high school athletic Alaska's attorney teams. general must approve the ban before it can take effect.
